**Monthly Summary for the Cabinet for the month of August, 2016 in respect of Ministry of Coal.****A. Principal Activities**

The core objectives of the Ministry of Coal are to augment coal production by adopting state-of-the-art clean-coal technologies; enhancing exploration efforts with thrust on increasing proven coal resources and developing necessary infrastructure for prompt evacuation of coal for securing its availability to meet the demand of different sectors of the economy in an eco-friendly and sustainable manner.

**B. Important decisions taken during August, 2016**

In accordance with the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Act, 2015, allotment agreements have been executed on 24th August, 2016 w.r.t. 5 coal mines, out of 8 coal mines earmarked for allotment to State PSU's of coal bearing host States for sale of coal. These 5 coal mines and its allottee companies are as under:

In accordance with Rule 8(2) (a) (ii) and Rule 11(1) of the coal mines (Special Provisions) Rules, 2014, directions have been issued on 29.08.2016 to the nominated authority to execute an allotment agreement and consequently issue an allotment order in respect of Amelia coal mine in favour of THDC India Limited.

4. A provisional list of admissible compensation amount for land and mine infrastructure in respect of 31 coal mines has been advertised in the newspapers and hosted on the website of Ministry of Coal.

3. Promotional and Detailed drilling

**Promotional Drilling:** In Annual Plan 2016-17, a target of 1.75 lakh metre of Promotional drilling (0.90 lakh metre in coal and 0.85 lakh metre in lignite) had been envisaged. During the year 2016-17, the achievement of drilling upto the month of August, 2016 is 0.39 lakh metre.

**Overall Progress of Detailed Drilling in:** For Annual Plan 2016-17, a target of 11.0 lakh metre of drilling (Departmental: 4.0 lakh metre, Outsourcing: 7.0 lakh metre) had been envisaged. As against this, 3.67 lakh metre of drilling has been carried out upto the month of August, 2016.

4. Specific steps under taken by the Ministry/Department for utilization of the Space Technology based tools and applications in Government and Development.

The Following three projects have been identified for use of Space Technology in CIL

- (i) Air pollution monitoring.
- (ii) Coal fire mapping and subsidence mapping.
- (iii) Capacity building in CMPDIL for SAR interferometry towards fire and subsidence mapping.

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
