g) **Event Description:** Nutrients help the organisms to derive energy, build muscles, cure deficiency diseases, fulfil mineral needs and provide fluid to various parts of the body. Nutrition is very important for the organ systems to coordinate well for the overall growth and development of the whole body of the organism. The nutritional stores of a lactating woman may be more or less depleted as a result of the pregnancy and the loss of blood during childbirth. Lactation raises nutrient needs, mainly because of the loss of nutrients, first through colostrum and then through breastmilk. Nutritional camp organized at Banauli village, total 125 Pregnant ladies, lactating mothers and mal nutritional children given nutritional supplements. Well-nourished women are better able to provide for themselves, their children, and their families. Well-nourished mothers are more likely to have infants with healthy birth weights, and such children are less likely to ever suffer from malnutrition.

g) **Event Description:** On the occasion of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, Medical camps were held in the command area of Central Coalfield Limited. The Medical camps were held from 01.02.2023 to 01.04.2023 for the various beneficiaries/ local villagers . On 1.02.2023, Barkasayal area held a general disease camp in which the doctors attended to a total of 160 beneficiaries, Kathara area organized a village health camp in which 118 local villagers were provided with treatment and medicines for anemia detection by 2 doctors from area hospital.medical camps provide free medical advice, medicine to the unfortunate people and refer for specialized treatment or surgery whenever it is required. These camps make sure people are getting

the healthcare at the right time, and seeing the doctor early enough before a small health problem turns serious.

**b) 02.03.2023**

On 02.03.2023, Dhori command area organized CSR Mega health camp at Chando Panchayat Petarwar under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava. More than 450 patients were treated. Ten Doctors and medical specialists from Central Hospital Dhori treated and provided free medicine and testing. Following specialist doctors treated patients Skin, orthopedics, gynecologist, Dental, General physicians, ophthalmologists, ENT specialist and others. Piparwar command area also held a village health camp under AKAM by the Regional Hospital ,Bachra in which around 104 beneficiaries have been benefited and medicines are distributed among them . Hazaribagh command area also conducted Anemia detection, Diabetes & hypertension & General disease camp at panchayat bhawan Tapin under CSR Activities of 75 Azadi ka amritmahotsav. The village health camp was inaugurated by Staff Officer (P & A)/H in which a total of 127 No. Of beneficiaries were treated, Blood sugar done 49, high blood sugar detected in 9. Hb% done in 40, below 10 gm found in 16.

**c) 03.02.2023 :**

C.S.R Mega Health camp was organized (03.02.2023) by the B & K area under "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav" at Jaridih East Panchayat, Bermo, Bokaro. The medical camp specially focused on Diabetics, Hypertension and other related diseases. 05 nos of Doctors and 10 nos of non- medical staff are involved in this camp. A large number of villagers are taking advantage of this camp. Medical camps provide free medical advice, medicine to the unfortunate people and refer for specialized treatment or surgery whenever it is required. These camps make sure people are getting the healthcare at the right time, and seeing the doctor early enough before a small health problem turns serious.
