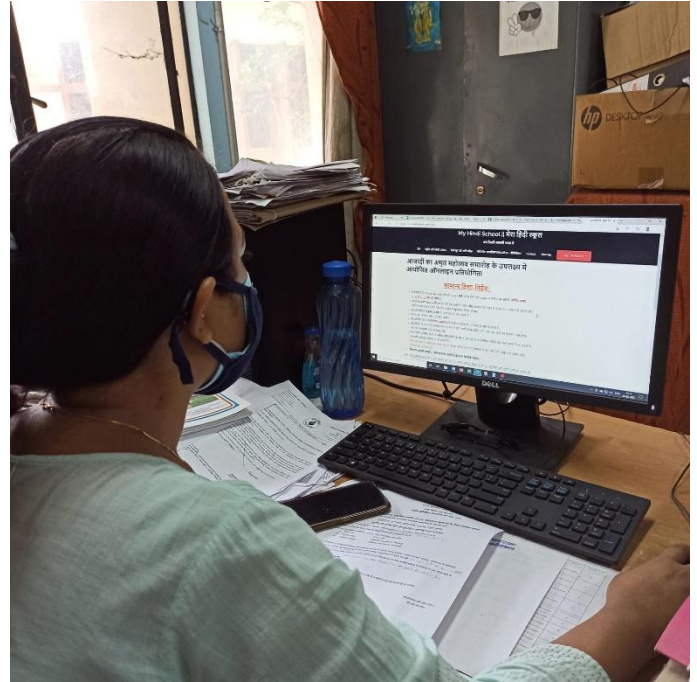
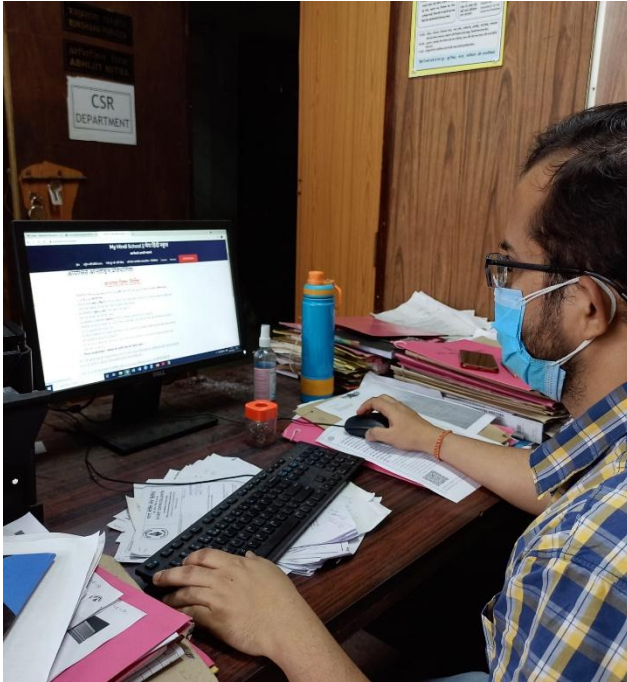

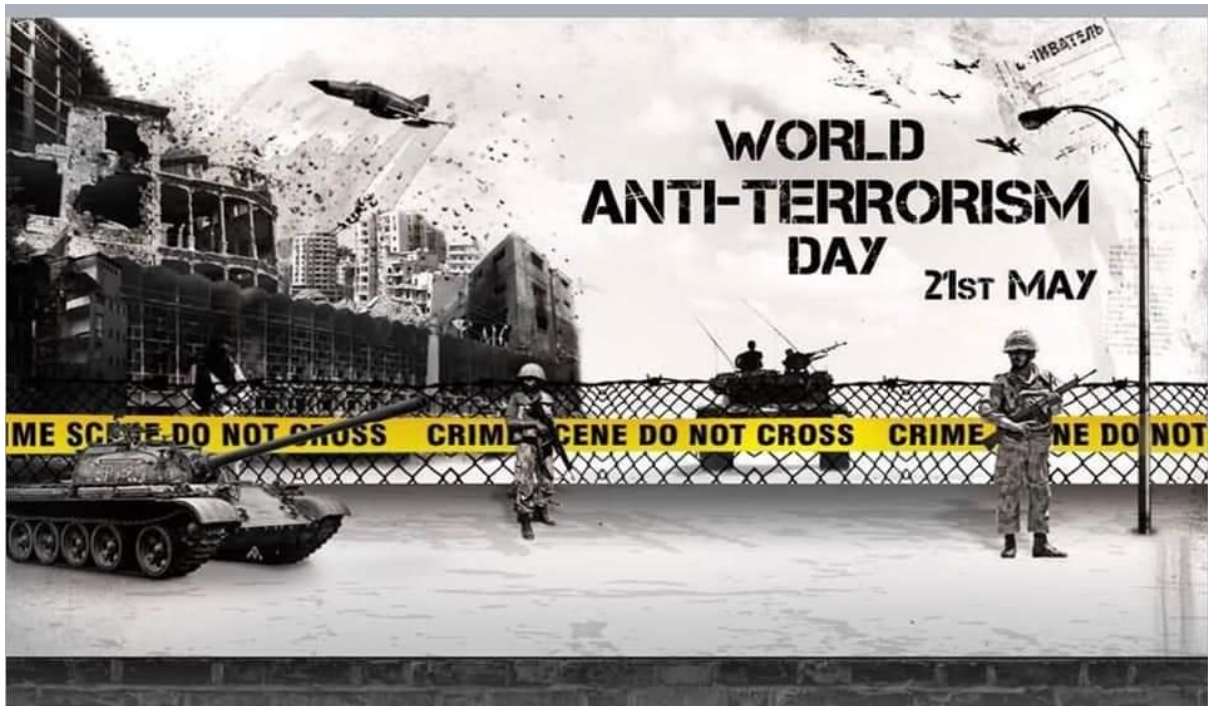
The students captured some beautiful clips of the nature in its calmness through their mobile phones.
