**g) Event Description:** In this context a discussion programme was organized in Area HeadQuarter, Raigarh on Possibilities of business diversification for achieving futuristic goals.

1. **Renewable Energy:** Invest in renewable energy sources such as solar, wind, or hydropower. This would involve developing and operating renewable energy projects, allowing CIL to reduce its carbon footprint and tap into the growing renewable energy market.
2. **Energy Storage Solutions:** With the increasing demand for energy storage solutions, CIL could explore opportunities in battery storage technologies. This could involve manufacturing or partnering with companies involved in the production of advanced energy storage systems.

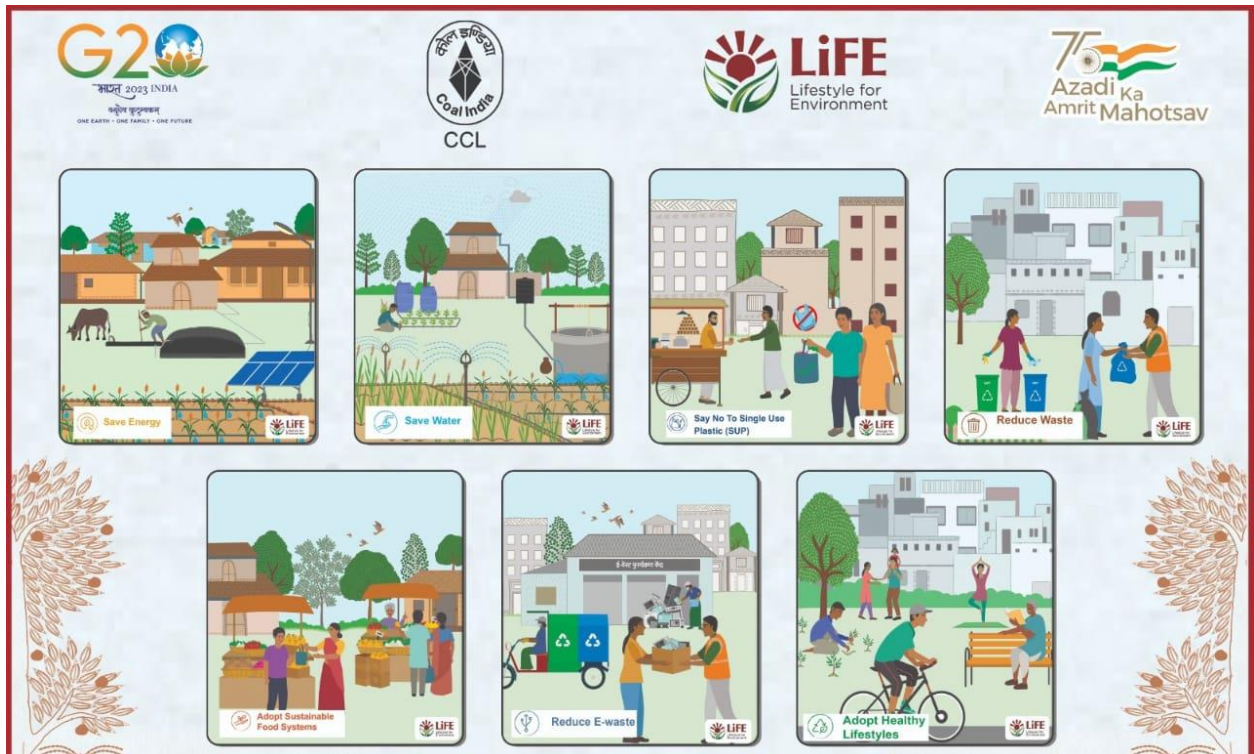
