Now in this above mentioned context, ECL, under its CSR policy is providing free medical health camps at various villages in surrounding places of its Areas to give free or subsidised health checkup and medicine and helping the Government to eradicate many disease as preventive healthcare enhances health and promote equality by benefitting mostly the disadvantaged and marginalized group.
