
AKAM Activities by CIL and its subsidiaries 12th Week (24.05.2021-29.05.2021)

<u>2. CCL</u>




As most of the students are from remote corners of different districts, the students were told to click creative picture which also potray the greenery of their surroundings.

The students caputred and shared some beautiful pictures through their mobile phones.










2. <u>ECL</u>

3. <u>MCL</u>










5. <u>WCL:</u>
