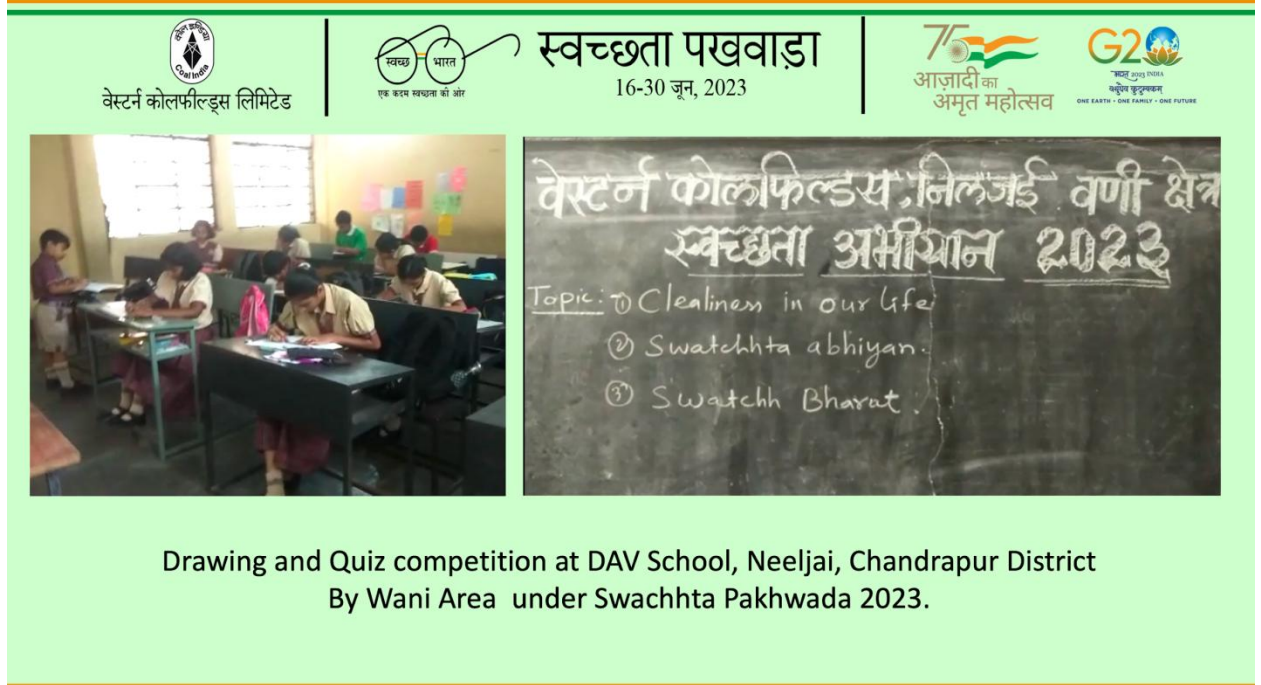
g) Event Description: Nutritional distribution program organized from CSR head of SECL Sohagpur area

Under the guidance of Regional General Manager Mr. P. Srikrishna, nutrition material is being distributed with the help of District Women and Child Development Department, Shahdol under the guidance of Regional General Manager Mr. P. Srikrishna for malnourished children registered in various Anganwadi centers around SECL Sohagpur area, through which about 250 children are getting benefited and the sanctioned amount of the work is Rs 4 lakh. In the nutritional content, Soybean and coral based Morvita powder full of naturally prepared nutrients is being made available to the children through Anganwadi workers. Under this program, on 20.06.2023, nutritional material was distributed to 18 children along with their parents in Tikuriya Tola of Bakho sector. Anganwadi Sector Officer, workers and Community Development Officer from SECL Sohagpur area Mr. Gaurav Singhal was present in the programme. g) Brief Description of the event :

Under a special intervention undertaken under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav “Clean Kolkata Initiative” specially designed dustbins made out of eco friendly material are being distributed across Kolkata at different auto and cab stands. An small awareness session is also being done in the process of distribution. Also, these dustbins will help in making citizens aware not to litter plastic especially multi-layer plastics that harm the environment by either blocking the drains or accumulating in the landfills. The car dustbins has been designed for easy installation, washing and reuse. A target of 800 such car dustbins are to be distributed in the different areas ok Kolkata during the AKAM period. The long campaign activity has benefitted around 300 persons till date and more 500 public transport system owners will be benefitted.
