g) **Event Description:** Under the guidance of Mr. Arun Kumar Parmar, Collector of Singrauli under the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) of Block B area. N.C.L. Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between **Block-B area and Farmers Welfare and Agriculture Development Department, Singrauli, Madhya Pradesh** under **Hybrid Kharif Seeds Distribution Scheme** to make **10000** farmers self-sufficient in agriculture.

Under this MoU costing ₹ 98.72 lakh, it is proposed to distribute 3 kg of hybrid kharif seeds per farmer at the rate of ₹ 325 per kg to about 10000 farmers in the year 2023-24 in all the three blocks of Singrauli - Chitrangi, Devsar and Singrauli. It is to be implemented by **the Farmers Welfare and Agriculture Development Department, Singrauli, Madhya Pradesh**, for which a total amount of ₹ 98.72 Lakh has been transferred under the head of Corporate Social Responsibility of NCL.

In the first phase of **hybrid kharif seeds distribution program**, 3 kg seeds were distributed to 250 farmers of Budhadol village of Chitrangi tehsil of Singrauli at the rate of ₹ 325 per kg.

The MoU was signed between **Mr. Saeed Ghori, Regional General Manager**, on behalf of Block B Project and **Mr. Ashish Pandey, Deputy Director**, on
