
AKAM Activities by CIL and its subsidiaries 14th Week (6th to 12th June, 2021)





2) MCL

3) NCL

CMD NCL meets Hon'ble Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan.10 crore given for oxygen plant in 05 medical colleges of Madhya Pradesh In order to equip the healthcare infrastructure with state-of-the-art facilities in the light of COVID-19, NCL has provided an amount of 10 crores to Public Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). With this collaboration, five PSA oxygen plants of 1500 LPM capacity will be set up in medical colleges operating at Bhopal, Indore, Rewa, Jabalpur and Sagar. This initiative of NCL will strengthen the state's campaign against Covid. Along with this, the company has also given an assistance of 1.75 crore for the establishment of an Oxygen Generating Plant at AIIMS, Bhopal for the treatment and rescue of patients suffering from Kovid-19 from its CSR item.
