


The resource person shared his expertise on the subject.


# "National Clean Air Programme and challenges for sustainable air environment in mining areas"




The plantation drive has been carried out at 3.7 ha. of land under Mission JAGGRAN & SAMBANDH of ECL.


## Webinar on Quite India Movement Day:

During the event the students have shared their knowledge and discussed on this Historic Movement of India's freedom struggle.








#### 5. <u>WCL</u>


#### 9. MCL
