

**Brief of Activities conducted of AKAM by CIL and Subsidiaries**  
**24<sup>th</sup> Week (16.08.2021-22.08.2021)**

**1. BCCL :**

Bharat Coking Coal Limited is celebrating “Tree Plantation Campaign 2021” launched by the Union Minister of Coal, Mines and Parliamentary Affairs Shri Pralhad Joshi in the presence of Shri Raosaheb Patil Danve, Minister of State for Coal, Mines and Railways on 19th August 2021. This was an important program under the "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav".

In this plantation drive 2021, 5225 people participated in mines and washeries of different areas of Bharat Coking Coal Limited. Chief Vigilance Officer, Kumar Animesh; Director (Technology) Operations, Shri Chanchal Goswami; Director (Personnel) Shri PVKM Rao and various General Managers/Heads of the Headquarters attended and planted trees in the office premises. Director Finance participated in the program online. Arrangements were also made in MT Hostel and tree plantation was done by the Management Trainee.

Under this program, 17570 tree plantations were done at 58 places of BCCL in the presence of the dignitaries of Dhanbad region and 16500 saplings were distributed among the common people.

20 out of 58 plantation sites were linked to the tree plantation program of the Ministry through live video conferencing.

## 5. NCL:

Minister of Coal, Mines and Parliamentary Affairs, Government of India has e-launched the "Plantation Campaign 2021"

E-inauguration of Mudwani Dam Eco Park developed by NCL

Plantation of about 1 lakh saplings being done in NCL under the campaign.

Mudwani Dam Eco Park inaugurated:

During the program, Mudwani Dam Eco Park spread over an area of 84000 square meters, being developed by NCL, was inaugurated to promote mining and eco-tourism in Singrauli region. An MoU was signed between NCL Jayant and Municipal Corporation, Singrauli in the Middle East for the development of this Eco Park. NCL, in association with Madhya Pradesh Tourism, is working on a plan to promote mine and eco-tourism by connecting this park with the "Singrauli Eco Tourism Circuit". This will provide employment and business opportunities to the local people.

Massive tree plantation drive started in NCL:

During this festival more than one lakh saplings are being planted in about 100 acres of land at 13 plantation sites of all the projects/units of NCL. Along with this, more than 27 thousand fruit plants like mango, amla, pomegranate, guava, litchi, lemon, jackfruit, jamun etc. are being distributed among the local citizens.

It is worth mentioning that for plantation, two places in Jayant and Dudhichua and one each in Amlori, Nigahi, Block B, Jhingurda, Khadia, Krishnashila, Kakri, Bina, Central Workshop, Jayant have been earmarked, where during plantation the district Officers of administration and forest department, village sarpanch and NCL officials were present.







#### 6. MCL:
