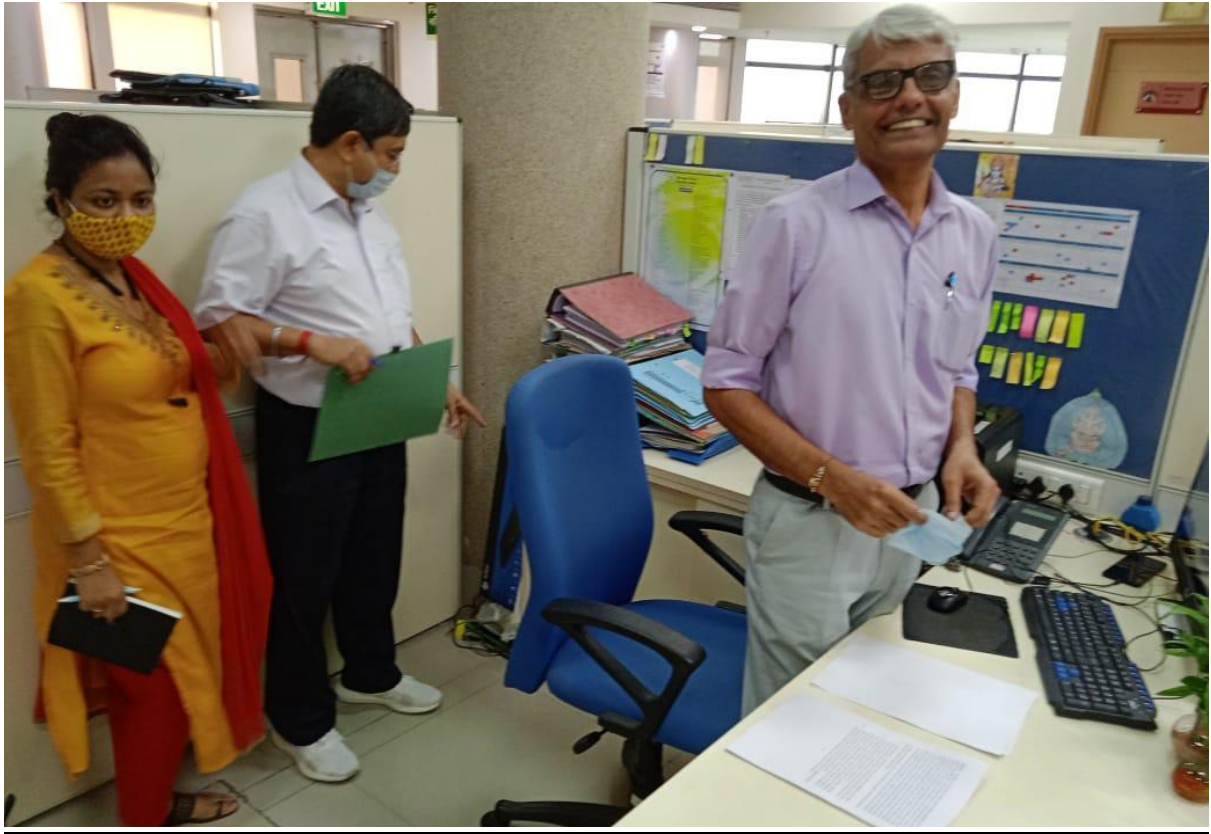






7. CIL
