- f) Brief Description of Event -A 3 day mega health camp was organized by CSR team of Argada Area from 13 th Dec to 15th Dec 2021. The health camp consisted of a child specialist, gynaecologist and eye specialist for attending the health needs of the people of the local villages from the nearby places of ArgadaArea . Special cataract screening drive was conducted during this 3 day camp. A team of Doctors from CHR visited and conducted the medical camp. Cataract positive cases from this camp will undergo free operation at Central Hospital Ramgarh. : On the Day 2 of free medical camp at Giddi A, Argada Area the camp saw a footfall of 120 people. Along with the free medical camp, free medicines were also distributed to the people who came from remote corners of the command area to seek support and medical aid.
- On the Day 3 of free medical camp at Giddi C, Argada Area, more than 400 villagers came and were benefited from this 3 day camp at Aragda area. All cataract detected cases to undergo free surgery during camp at Central Hospital Ramgarh.
- Solar lamps were distributed to the local villagers and the PAPs of the command area by the Argada area under Action @75 of AKAM. Solar lights were distributed which will help the people form the rural households in the command area.
- Dry food grains and other essentials were distributed to families below poverty line under AKAM by the CSRArgada Team. Large numbers of villagers from the nearby places of the command area participated in this distribution drive.
- Under the theme of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava a "Rural Badminton Tournament" was organised on 17th and 18th Dec at Indoor Badminton court, Kargali Football ground (B&K Area). The tournament was organised to motivate and support the local people from the command area and to promote sports under Action@75 which is one of the five pillars of AKAM.

Energy Security: Awareness Programme

The 41st Week programme of Bharat Ka Amrut Mahotsav was scheduled as "**Energy Security: Awareness programme**" about climate change and global warming in view of National Energy Conservation Day (on 14th December). The aim of the programme was to create awareness about use energy judiciously in everyday life, zero wastage and spread awareness about the importance of energy conservation for a healthy environment and sustainable future.

At Yellandu Area, the activity has been taken up and Sri M. Subba Rao, General Manager has addressed all employees that the exploitation of nature has resulted in the erosion of the environment, irreversible damage to nature, and environmental pollution.
