f) Brief Description of Event - Continuing with the Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav celebrations in BCCL, under the “Achievements @ 75” theme, an eco-tourism visit to Gokul Eco-cultural Park and NT-ST mines of BCCL was organized for final year students of Mining Engineering department of BIT, Sindri, Dhanbad.

A total of 38 Nos. of students along with three Asst. Professors of the Mining Engineering Dept. of BIT, Sindri visited Gokul Eco-cultural Park and NT-ST mines, Lodna Area, BCCL.

This eco-tourism visit was organized by Environment Department of BCCL in co-ordination with Lodna Area. Shri Arpan Haldar, Shri Neeraj Yadav and Shri Kapil Kumar, Asst. Professors of Mining Engineering Dept. of BIT, Sindri along with 38 students of Mining Engineering Department were accompanied by Shri Harish Pal, Dy. Manager (Env.); Meena Kumari, Dy. Manager (Env.) of Environment Dept. & Rukshana Praveen, Dy. Manager (CD), CSR Dept. to Gokul Eco-cultural Park, Lodna Area.

Students were welcomed at the site by Shri. S. P. Tiwary, Manager (Min.) NT-ST Colliery, Shri Gautam Prasad, Dy. Manager (Min.), Shri Sujit Kumar, Dy. Manager (Min.) & Aashu Kumar Gupta, Asst. Manager (Min.). During the visit, the students were briefed about the mining activities, fire dealing operation at BCCL mines and reclamation of the mined out areas and development of the eco-parks. They were also informed that, the reclamation activities shall also be planned in a way that it should not only helps in development of the green cover but inclusively helps in restoration of the ecology and biodiversity. It was demonstrated to the students that the reclaimed land may be put up to better land use by means of development of eco-parks mutually benefitting ecology and the local communities. Students were also informed that for the establishment of the biodiversity 3-tier ecological restoration method has been adopted in which grass, shrubs and native species flora has been established.

Gokul Eco-restoration Park has been developed on an OB dump which has now been transformed into beautiful landscape and is a popular spot among the local people for the recreation and rejuvenation activities. Establishment of the temple in the eco-park has affiliated the local communities in the religious way and this eco-park now holds a place of prominence among the locals.

Students were amazed to see that the degraded mined out land could be transformed into such beautiful and green eco-park and a place of attraction. They appreciated the efforts of the company.

- f) Brief Description of Event - Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) Signing Ceremony of 'Conducting skill development training to 80 underprivileged/unemployed/underemployed youths of Jharkhand in Machine Operator (6-month course)' by Central Institute of Petrochemicals Engineering & Technology (CIPET) Centre for Skilling & Technical Support (CSTS) was organized on 21.12.2021 at CMPDIL. The project is being funded by CMPDIL under its CSR for F.Y. 2021-22 for 80 students in two batches.

Forty beneficiaries would be trained in Machine Operator –Plastics Processing (MO-PP) and forty in Machine Operator –Injection Molding Technology at CIPET, Hehal, Ranchi. The minimum educational qualification required for the candidates is Std. 8th. The courses will be of six-month duration, aligned to NSQF & approved by National Skills Qualification Committee (NSQC) – National Skill Development Agency (NSDA), Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India. CMPDIL has approved Rs. 68.00 lakh for said project under CMPDIL, CSR F.Y. 2021-22.
