Shri Samiran Dutta, CMD, BCCL, Shri PVKRM Rao, D (P), BCCL, Shri Sanjay Kumar Singh, DT (OP), BCCL, Shri Kumar Animesh, CVO, BCCL and senior officials of BCCL were present on the occasion online from Koyla Bhawan, BCCL HQ. Commissioning of this washery is a magnificent effort by BCCL towards import substitution of coking coal in India which is very relevant in the present context where cost of steel production is a great challenge for the steel makers due to the very high price of imported coking coal. This is a way forward towards import substitution by enhancing the supply of indigenous washed coking coal at competitive prices for the steel sector to propel the growth of our country. Product quality is an important issue and acquires a central position in building NEW CLEAN INDIA. This washery will ensure supply of consistent quality washed coking coal to the steel sector ensuring effective utilization of our scarce coking coal reserves through efficient washing. This washery has the capacity to save around Million \$US 576 per annum at its peak capacity i.e. 20 Mtpa washed coal, which may be considered as a great leap towards Atma Nirbhar Bharat.
