The awareness programme on World No Tobacco Day was organized in Ramagundam-2 Area by Health Officer Dr.Padma. She addressed that World No Tobacco Day is marked every year on 31<sup>st</sup> May to spread awareness about the adverse effects of smoking. The main aim of the day is to highlight the risk associated with the use of tobacco and to protect the health of people. She explained the harmful effect of tobacco on our health.

The World Environment Day on 5<sup>th</sup> June was organized in all the areas of SCCL.
