g) Event Description: Coal is primarily used as fuel to generate electric power in the United States. In coal-fired power plants, bituminous coal, subbituminous coal, or lignite is burned. The heat produced by the combustion of the coal is used to convert water into high-pressure steam, which drives a turbine, which produces electricity. ECL continues its technological transformation to produce more coal to serve the Nation. During the AKAM the company has commissioned a Hydraulic Shovel at its Kunustoria Area. Total 5 nos such types of shovels have been commissioned at different coal mines of ECL and it has been commissioned for the first time at ECL. It has a capacity to extract Coal or Over burden of 5.6 cubic mtr. and is able to extract more than 12 lakh cubic mtr in a year.

#### g) Event Description:

When we segregate waste, it reduces the amount of waste that reaches landfills, thereby taking up less space. Pollution of air and water can be considerably reduced when hazardous waste is separated and treated separately. It is essential that waste is put in separate bins so that it can be appropriately dealt with. Under the Waste Regulations 2011, we must segregate paper, cardboard, plastic, metal and glass at source unless it is technically or economically unfeasible. Under the same regulations, we should implement the waste hierarchy; reduce, reuse, recycle, other recovery and disposal. By law, we should implement this hierarchy and segregation helps with recycling in particular. Hence, 6 numbers of waste bins were distributed and placed at prominent location in the residential complex of rohini housing colony, where employees of CIL reside.
