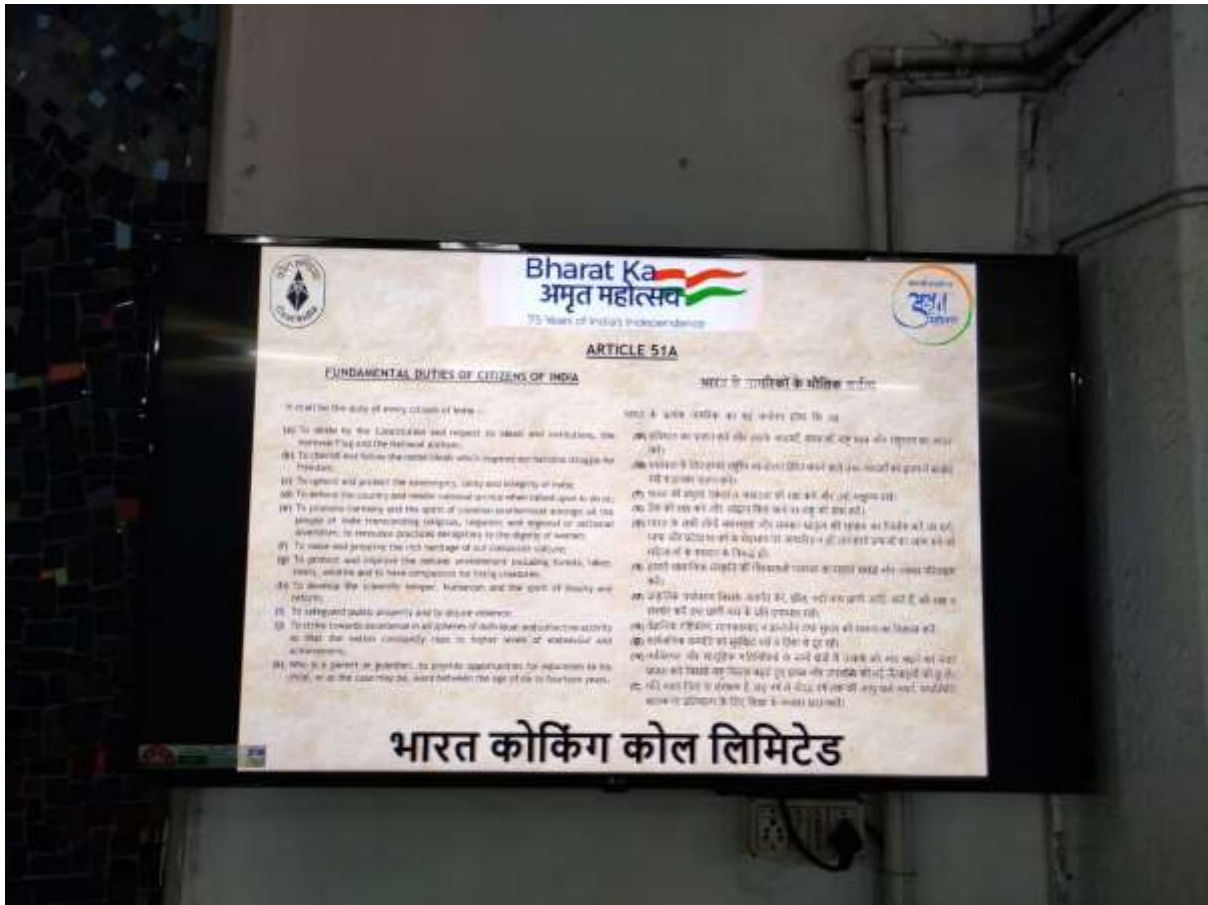



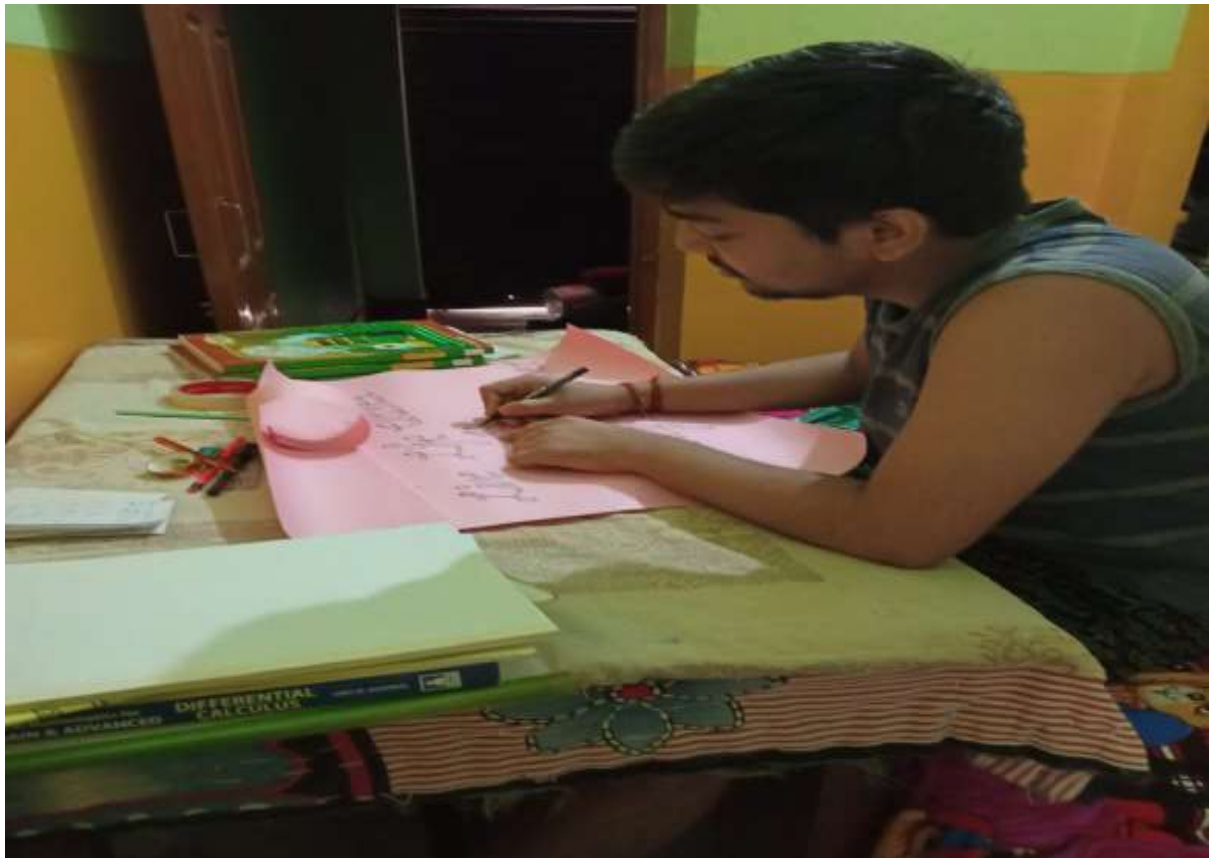

Area- Jamuna Kotma

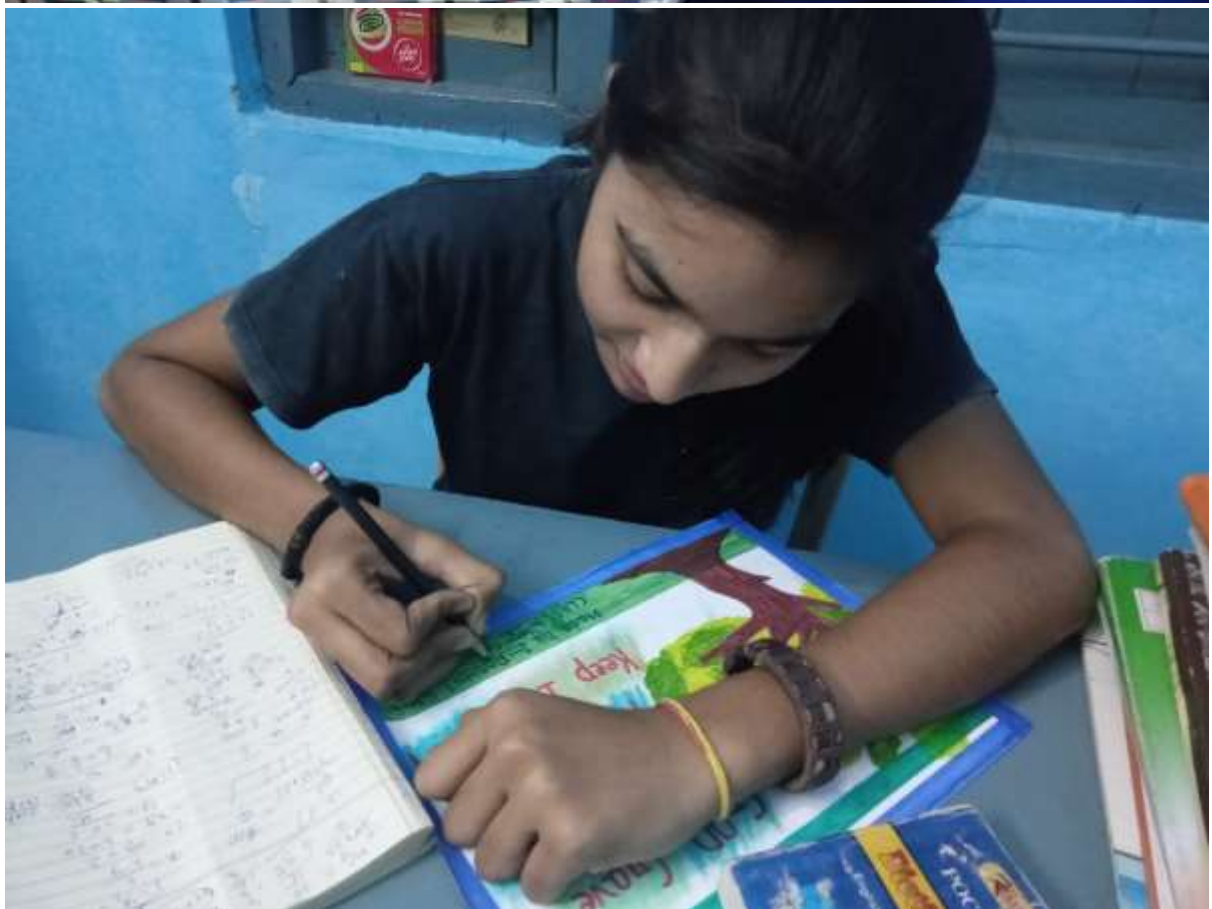
Activity: - Organization of poster competition for students of Kendriya Vidyalaya, Jamuna Colliery, Dist. Anuppur
