1. <u>BCCL</u>



Dr. Dash explained about various infections and diseases that the large ruminants are vulnerable to and how to avoid them. Discussing about the importance of AI, he explained how a breed enhancement can result into enhanced livelihood management.

Apart from these large ruminant animals' breed enhancement and management, Dr. Dash explained about goat rearing and poultry rearing. Goat ad poultry rearing being short income models can be accepted by villagers with less land holding and can get most benefits out if it. Goat and poultry being low investment high output models should be promoted and followed by farmers to cope up better during the lean agricultural periods.

May 9, is celebrated as Rabindra Nath Tagore Jayanti in India in 2021. Tagore was one of the world's most prolific writers and poet and has also been awarded a Nobel prize in literature. Tagore was the first person from India to have ever been awarded the Nobel prize. His work primarily consisted of Bengali and English literature. Tagore inspired thousands of writers that came after him and was one of the most revered writers in the country. On the occasion of Rabindranath Tagore Jayanti, he was remembered by garlanding of photographs by the officials of Bankola Area, ECL.


