g) **Event Description:** Under the Health & Wellness Campaign of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav(AKAM), WCL Majri Area organized a grand health check-up camp on 26.11.22 in village Marda, Chandrapur District. Pediatric check-up (including height and weight graph), general check-up and blood pressure screening were also done under the camp. The camp was inaugurated by Shri Balaji Jogi, Sarpanch of SurbhiMahila Mandal. The team of Regional Hospital in which Regional Medical Officer Dr. KJ Umbarkar, Dr. Neha Ghagi, Dr. Lakshmi Lavanyaetc all contributed to the camp. A total of 65 children were tested in the camp. Some of the tested children (Rickets, vitA deficiency, iron deficiency anemia etc.) were advised to come to the regional hospital for further treatment. A total of 287 patients were examined.
