The wheelchair is one of the most commonly used assistive devices to promote mobility and enhance quality of life for people who have difficulties in walking (e.g. a person with spinal cord injuries resulting in quadriplegia or paraplegia, muscular dystrophy, etc). If it has become difficult for people with disability or old age to complete even basic everyday tasks without pain or extreme fatigue, wheelchair assistance may be inevitable. Coal India Limited, in association with the Biddhan Nagar Police Commissionerate, has distributed wheelchairs to the less fortunate in an effort to empower them and enhance their quality of life. A road marking machine, for marking on roads to facilitate navigation for motorists and pedestrians has also been provided by CIL. In addition to providing mobility, an appropriate wheelchair benefits the physical health and quality of life of the users by helping in reducing common problems such as pressure sores, progression of deformities and improve respiration and digestion.
