g) **Event Description:** Under Health & Wellness Campaign of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav(AKAM), WCL Wani North Area organized a BMD Bone Mineral Density (BMD) test measures how much calcium and other types of minerals are in an area of your bone on 11.12.22 at Lathi village . The camp was inaugurated by ShriAlokLalit Kumar, Area General Manager, Wani North Area. Orthopedic Dr. Kulkarni of ChandrapurArea along with a team of WCL doctors Dr. Prashant, Dr. Pavani, Dr. Surya have attended the patients in the camp. Many local villagers were benefitted of this camp organized by the regional hospital team, Kanhan Area. They have examined the women of above 40 age group and 92 women are beneficiaries in the camp. They have provided 1,2 or 3 months of medicines to the womens who are having calcium deficiency in calcium. They have also advised some exercise to avoid back pain & neck Pain.

g) **Event Description:** Giridih is one of the 14 Command areas of Central Coalfields Limited which is located in the remote corners of the State of Jharkhand. In such a place, access to quality medication and treatment is not possible for the local villagers/people who are residing in and around the area, as a solution to this problem, Digital Dispensaries were installed in the hospital of Giridih project. This digital dispensary will allow the local people/ villagers and the project affected people to get access to complete primary and emergency healthcare solutions such as consultation, confirmatory tests, and medicines from a single point. This device will allow for checkups from experienced doctors who can treat and examine from a different location than the patient as the digital dispensary solves the long distance problem that villagers/ people have to travel to reach the city for accessing the better quality of treatment and medication. In the time of

emergency it is not possible to travel to a location for someone who needs urgent care . Similarly, these digital dispensaries will also be installed in the other hospitals in the different units of Central Coalfields Limited for helping the project affected people, people/ villagers for getting consultations from a single point.
