Minutes of meeting chaired by Additional Secretary (MN) and Nominated Authority on 21stOct 2022 at 11:00 AM to review coal production and target coal production from Captive/Commercial Coal Blocks.

# The list of participants is in Annexure-I.

At the outset, Additional Secretary (MN) and Nominated Authority welcomed all the participants. It was stated that 48 coal blocks have got mine opening permission, out of which 37 coal blocks are under coal production and about 10 additional coal blocks are expected to start coal production during FY 2022-23.

It was also informed that 55.39 MT coal has been produced till 20.10.2022 against annual coal production target of 141.78 MT committed by Project Proponents for current financial year. It is expected that at least 70 MT additional coal will be produced during remaining period of FY 2022-23. Allottees were asked to give their estimate for coal production for remaining period of current financial year and for next financial year against each coal block .It was informed that about 162.14 MT is expected to be produced in FY 2022-23. Mine-wise discussions were held:

### 1. Pachhwara North (M/s WBPDCL)

5.09 MT coal has been produced during April-September 2022 against pro rata target of 6.07 MT and the achievement is only 83.73%. Allottee informed that Director General of Forests has forwarded the FC Stage-II proposal to the Hon'ble Minister of MoEF&CC for approval and the FC-II will be obtained within a week. It is expected that all formalities including tree-cutting, forest land transfer etc. will take 3-4 months after approval of FC Stage-II. Allottee further informed that the revised Mine Plan for entire area will be uploaded on the portal today. It was also informed that 3MT coal was available in non-forest land and they will excavate this in next 2-3 months and further production will be dependent on transfer of forest land. Coal evacuation problem has been resolved with the start of Dumka rail siding, The commitment made by Allottee for coal production is given below:-

Regarding SPV, Allottee informed that the proposal has been submitted to Railway and a meeting is scheduled with Railway after Diwali festival. AS (MN) and NA asked Allottee to submit a detailed note on SPV and ministry will take up the issue with Railway.

## 2. Barjora (M/s WBPDCL)

0.11 MT coal has been produced during April-September 2022 against pro rata target of 0.08 MT and the achievement is 148.80 %. Allottee informed that coal reserve is already exhausted, and they will take out the remaining 40 to 50 thousand ton coal in current year.

#### 3. Barjora North (M/s WBPDCL)

0.94 MT coal has been produced during April-September 2022 against pro rata target of 0.77 MT and the achievement is 121.88%. Allottee informed that till now 50 % CA land has been arranged and efforts are being made for arrangement of balance CA land. It was informed that as per a circular of MoEF&CC, SPSU can make payment of compensation amount instead of arrangement of CA land, however, certificate of Chief Secretary of the state regarding non-availability of CA land is required. AS (MN) and NA advised Allottee to speed up the process of CA land arrangement. Allottee informed that they will produces 1.26 MT coal in remaining period of 2022-23, but due to CA land issue only 1.5 MT coal will be produced next year.

#### 4&5. Gangaramchak & Gangaramchak Bhadulia (M/s WBPDCL)

0.97 MT coal has been produced during April-September,2022 against pro rata target of 0.39 MT and the achievement is 247.17%. Allottee informed that the PRC of the mine is 1.0 MT and they have almost achieved it and therefore stopped production. They applied to CCO for revised mining plan for PRC of 3.0 MT. Allottee also informed that their proposal to MoEF&CC for 50 % enhancement in EC capacity has been deferred and they have been asked to submit the Mine Plan approved by MoC. Director (Tech)/NA apprised that in a recently held meeting, MoEF&CC has agreed to accept the proposal for EC enhancement in accordance with MoC's guideline dated 29.05.2020 for Mine Plan.

#### 6-7. Tara East & Tara West (M/s WBPDCL)

It was observed that coal production has not yet started while mine opening permission was granted on 17.03.2020. Allottee informed that MDO appointment has been cleared by their Board and the proposal has been sent to finance department of State Govt for approval. The life of mine is only 3 to 4 years and MDO has agreed to work for 3 to 4 years.

#### 8. Trans Damodar (M/s DPL)

0.19 MT coal has been produced during April-September,2022 against pro rata target of 0.37 MT and the achievement is 52.28%. The allottee informed that the land acquisition is under process and the shortage in production was due to heavy rainfall. It was informed that they will produce 8 LT in next two quarters, 3.6LT in Q3 and 4.4LT in Q4. Also, Allottee is in process to enhance 20% EC capacity and revision of Mining Plan which is expected to be completed this year.

#### 9. Dulanga (M/s NTPC)

2.96 MT coal has been produced during April-September,2022 against pro rata target of 3.25 MT and the achievement is 90.85%.

Allottee informed that overall NTPC produced 50% more coal in first half of current financial in comparison to last year. They will produce 7 MT in FY2022-23 which is the PRC of the mine. Allottee requested Ministry to help in facilitating evacuation of some families from the mine. They are in process of revising Mine Plan with 10.5 MT capacity and revised Mine Plan will be ready by first week of November. Allottee has committed to achieve 8.5 MT coal production in FY 2023-24.

Director (T)/NA asked Allottee to send the month wise scheduled coal production target for the Oct-March 2023 period.

#### 10. Talaipalli (M/s NTPC)

0.35 MT coal has been produced during April-September,2022 against pro rata target of 0.71 MT and the achievement is only 48.68%. Allottee informed that they will be able to produce 2MT coal in this financial year and committed to produce 6 MT coal in next FY 2023-24.

Regarding evacuation infrastructure, Allottee informed that 60 KM MGR is ready. MGR passes through SECL mines and SECL has given permission for that.

#### 11. Pakri Barwadih (M/s NTPC)

5.46 MT coal has been produced during April-September 2022 against pro rata target of 6.08 MT and the achievement is 89.82%. Allottee informed that the coal production is 60 % more over previous year for the same period. Shortage in coal coal production was due to local habitation and R&R issues. The allottee has requested help from Ministry for expediating evacuation of family of 7 villages. It was also informed that the coal evacuation is a challenge in this mine and the wharfall work by Railway is going very slow. With the area of North Pakri Barwadih, the PRC of mine increases from 15 MT to 18 MT and they are in process of getting EC and FC for this additional area of North Pakri Barwadih. The allottee informed that they will definitely produce 14 MT in FY2022-23 and they will produce 17 MT in FY 2023-24.

Allottee informed that Coal production has started recently from 29<sup>th</sup> September 2022. They will achieve 2MT production target in FY 2022-23 and they will produce 6.0 MT coal in next year.

Allottee also stated that for the next year, it is hard to make any commitment for coal production till the issue of diversion of road is resolved. However, they will try to resolve the road diversion issue and will try to produce as much coal as possible. Allottee stated that the washery permission on quarterly basis is not adequate and requested to increase it for 6 months as there is no sufficient stockyard for washeries. AS(MN) and NA stated that as 15 to 20 days' time is being taken in getting permission for washery, present system is adequate.

#### 15. Manoharpur (M/s Odisha Coal & Power Ltd)

4.06 MT coal has been produced during April-September,2022 against pro rata target of 4.56 MT and the achievement is 89.11%. Allottee informed that they will be able to produce only 8 MT of coal in FY2022-23 against target of 10.0 MT and committed to achieve 10 MT coal production in FY 2023-24. MoEF&CC has restricted sale of coal up to 25% only and that too is for 18 months only. The distance of private siding from pithead is 25 KM. It was advised that that they should tie up with NTPC for dispatch of coal beyond 25% of production and NTPC Dallaipali has also requested for lifting coal from this mine.

Further they also informed that their proposal for enhancement in EC capacity from 2.8 MT to 3.92 MT per annum was deferred by the EAC in its meeting dated 26.09.2022 citing lack of approved mining plan by MoC, wildlife conservation plan and Year wise production status separately for OC and UG. Director (Tech)/NA apprised that in a recently held meeting, MoEF&CC has agreed to accept the proposal for EC enhancement in accordance with MoC's guideline dated 29.05.2020 for Mine Plan. Allottee informed that they are in process of submitting the above and will produce 3.36MT coal subject to grant of enhancement of EC. They committed to produce 3.92 MT coal next year.

They are confident of achieving the PRC target of 2.5 MT. Also, they committed for only 2.5 MT of production in the next financial year due to limited coal reserves and land acquisition issue.

The Allocatee informed that the coal production was hampered in July –September 2022 quarter due to heavy rain. They will be able to achieve only 1.6 MT coal production against the target of 2.5 MT due to inordinate delay in transfer of forest land by State Govt. Further he informed that the Maharashtra Government has handed over the forest land only recently and thanked coal ministry for providing necessary support in resolving the issue. They will produce 2.5 MT coal i.e. PRC in next year. They are in the process of EC capacity enhancement by 40%.

The Allottee informed that they will produce 5 MT coal in this financial year and in next year. Allottee informed that the coal evacuation is a big challenge. Coal is transported through 80 KM of public road maintained by PWD. Road condition is very bad. They along with other coal producers has taken the work of maintenance of 7.5 KM of road. AS(MN) and NA advised Allottee to take initiative along with other coal producers/transporters who are using that road for maintenance of whole 80 KM stretch of public road for their own benefits. Allottee further informed that they will make their own siding in next 2 years. GR is under

preparation for extra 59 Ha of land and once the GR is ready, they will go for capacity enhancement.

Now the problem has been resolved and tree cutting has resumed. They will try to cover the shortage of coal production in next 2 quarters and will try for 15 MT coal production by March end. After Diwali, 3-4 rakes per day coal will be dispatched and it will increase to 11 rakes per day by 2<sup>nd</sup> week of November. They have committed for 15 MT coal production for next year also. If additional land is provided, they will go for 18 MT next year but it cannot be committed at this moment.

Coal production has started, and about 16000-ton coal has been produced. Coal samples have been collected from mine, however, grade declaration has not been done by CCO till date and due to this coal evacuation is not taking place and coal production has been stopped. They are hopeful to start coal evacuation from November first week. They have installed 2 surface miners and hopeful to produce 2.0 MT coal in this financial year. Allottee assured that if coal production is allowed by MoEF&CC, they will produce 2.5 MT coal in current year and 10 MT coal in next year.

Due to restriction of NGT, they were unable to work on basis of 4th revision of Mine Plan and continued working as per 3rd revised Mine Plan. They have also withdrawn the proposal for 5th revision of Mine Plan. And thus they will continue working on basis of 3rd revised Mine Plan.
