(e) The Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Second Ordinance, 2014

Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vides judgment dated 25th August, 2014 and Order dated 24th September, 2014, had cancelled the allocation of 204 coal blocks on the grounds that the mechanism for allocation of Coal blocks was non-transparent and discretionary.

Within 27 days of the judgment, the Government promulgated the Coal Mines (Special Provision) Ordinance, 2014 on 21st October, 2014 and the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Second Ordinance on 26th December, 2014 (now substituted by an Act of 2015) to provide for re-allocation of 204 coal mines and vesting of the right, title and interest in and over the land and mine infrastructure together with mining leases to successful bidders and allotters with a view to ensure continuity in coal mining operations and production of coal. The Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Rules, 2014 were also notified on 11th December, 2014. The allocation of cancelled coal blocks have been made in pursuance of the provisions of Ordinance and Rules made thereunder.

Under the provisions of the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) ordinance 2014, the Central Government has successfully auctioned 16 Schedule-II Coal Mines and 13 Schedule-III Coal Mines. Further, Allotment of 17 Schedule II Coal Mines and 21 Schedule-III Coal Mines/Blocks to Central/State Government Companies have also been successfully completed in record time.

The estimated amount of revenue to be generated from the Auction/Allotment of the Coal Mines/Blocks as mentioned above is about Rs. 335370 Crores. In addition, the likely benefit to consumers from 9 blocks auctioned for Power sector will be Rs. 69311 Crores approximately.

Further, under the "Auction by Competitive bidding Rules, 2012", 10 regionally explored coal blocks have been allotted to Central/State Government Companies. To replace the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Bill 2015 was period by both the houses of Parliament and to receive the assent of the Hon'ble President of India on 30.03.2015.
