I am directed to refer to copy of your letter No. MMN-1010/C.R.3286/IND-9 dated 01.08.2012 regarding administrative approval for grant of mining lease after enactment of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Amendment Act, 2010 providing for allocation of coal blocks by auction through competitive bidding which has come into force from 2nd February, 2012. Nerad Malegaon coal block has been allocated on 13.01.2006 under Section 3(3)(a)(iii) of the Coal Mines (Nationalisation) Act, 1973 in favour of M/s Gupta Metallics & Power Ltd. and M/s Gupta Coalfields & Washeries Ltd. The matter has been examined in the Ministry of Coal in consultation with the Ministry of Law and Justice, Department of Legal Affairs.

The Ministry of Law and Justice, Department of Legal Affairs vide their Note dated 29.10.2012 has concluded that "there does not appear any legal restriction in granting prior approval of the Central Government under section 5(1) of MMDR Act, 1957 to the companies which have already been allocated (selected) and allocation letters have been issued prior to the commencement of the Amendment Act, 2010".

In view of the above, the State Government is directed to take necessary action in accordance with the law and above clarification.
