**Minutes of the Meeting held on 20.06.2014 under Chairmanship of Additional Secretary (Coal) to reievew the progress of coal production from Captive Blocks during 2014-15.**

A meeting was held on 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2014 under the chairmanship of Additional Secretary (Coal) to monitor the progress of coal production from Captive Coal Blocks during the year 2014-15. The list of MOC officers and representatives of coal block allocatees, who participated in the meeting, are enclosed at **Annexure-I** and **Annexure-II** respectively.

Representatives of 21 coal block allocatees whose blocks have come under production but have not achieved peak rated capacity and 6 allocatees whose coal blocks are likely to come under production during 2014-15 were invited for the meeting.

Welcoming the officers and representatives of block allocatees to the meeting, AS (Coal) stated that the purpose of the meeting was to ascertain the likely coal production from the captive coal blocks during the year 2014-15. Captive Coal Block allocatees are required to achieve peak rated capacity (PRC) for mining of coal within the prescribed timeframe as per the approved mining plan. Thereafter, representatives of coal block allocatees were requested to intimate the expected coal production during the year 2014-15. They were also requested to bring any other issue hampering the development of coal block in achieving PRC to the notice of the Ministry of Coal and make all out efforts on their part to achieve production as per approved mine plan.

In the case of Barjora North allocated to DVC, it was observed that the production target this year was contingent on the resolution of issues with its joint venture partner EMTA. It was decided that this would be brought to the notice of Ministry of Power. Sarisatolli block allocated to CESC had projected this years' production target as 2.8 million tonnes which was lower than the approved mining plan of 3.5 million tonnes. CESC was asked to ensure that its production projection was as per the mining plan. It was observed that production from Marki Mangli-I allocated to BS Ispat was suffering due to bad roads/ traffic restrictions and EUP not getting enough iron ore.

Based on the review of the status of producing coal blocks which have not yet attained PRC and the coal blocks which were likely to commence production in 2014-15 as well as information/assurance given by the coal block allocatees for achieving the production during 2014-15, a table containing block-wise production likely to be achieved is given at **Annexure-III**.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the Chair.
