**Event Description:** Contaminated water and poor sanitation are linked to transmission of diseases such as cholera, diarrhoea, dysentery, hepatitis A, typhoid and polio. Absent, inadequate, or inappropriately managed water and sanitation services expose individuals to preventable health risks. The inauguration program of newly constructed RO plant at Rajmahal Area was held by the Area officials, in presence of Area General Manager and other HoDs of the said Area. Local residents with Union representatives, staffs and other officials were also. The purpose of the RO plant was to provide safe drinking water to the surrounding people at free of cost. This RO will benefit the surrounding villages of Lalmatia village and almost 10 thousand people will benefit from this project. The RO plant will be operated and maintained by the ECL authority.

Spreading education always occupies a significant place among the various services of **Ramakrishna Mission**. In 1928 **Swami Ishtananda**, a monk of **Ramakrishna Mission**, established this school in very humble way to impart primary education to the local poor people. Such an endeavor had not been made in this Island prior to that. This institution has been spreading the light of education in this island since then. The school is now recognized by **WBBSE**. It got this recognition on 1952. It is a Bengali medium Govt aided boys' school having classes V to X. It has a hostel facility for limited number of students. The Mission has a plan to upgrade the school from Secondary to Higher Secondary level in near future. Coal India under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav is constructing building for capacity building of 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> standard because they are more students in near proximity but there are not enough schools for them. The school building will be completed within June 2023.
