g) Event Description: Like every year @ECL organized a Tuberculosis awareness program at CH Kalla. The program was to raise public awareness about devastating health, social and economic consequences of TB and to step up efforts to end the pandemic. TB, being world's deadliest infectious killer, the death increased highest for the first time in decades in 2020

However, when it comes to combating infectious disease and associated risks in the work environment, a workplace intervention acts as a keystone. Mines are especially at the risk of TB since they usually work in cramped, underground mines, where ventilation is compromised and temperatures are

extreme. Additionally, prolonged exposure to chemicals and coal dust also weaken their lungs considerably.

ECL provides quality diagnostic and treatment services for TB to all the employees through a well-established medical set up. ECL also follows Revised National Tuberculosis Control Program (RNTCP) guidelines to treat indoor patients and refer the outdoor patients to District TB Cell. There is a budgetary provision for delivering comprehensive medical services. For specialized TB tests not available at ECL, patients are referred to the empanelled tertiary care hospitals. Medical reimbursements are given to employees who have purchased privately.

g) Event Description: Sambalpur is one of our four aspirational districts in which MCL has been taking up a lot of developmental works under its CSR initiatives. Health camp was organized by Aanand Vihar Hospital. Health camp covered important health priority areas like blood-pressure, heart-rate, diabetes, blood test etc. After assessing the health condition, patients are prescribed required health assistance and where they can avail those. Medicines were also distributed. Such health camps are utterly important for the rapid health service availability of rural populations. Health

camps are important as they primarily investigate the disease at times when they go unnoticed and prevention is any day better that cure.

machines are provided to people who got displaced due to expansion of coal blocks.

These machines are semi-automatic and can grind 60-80 KG in one hour.

120 men and women in 6-gram panchayats will benefit through this initiative. The initiative will run through self-help groups. 11 self-help groups are formed for running the machines.

These machines will help them to get a source of self-employment. This initiative will boost self-confidence among women associated with these self-help groups.

Self-help groups are basically consisting of tribal, people below poverty line, social and economically backward women.

The income generated will help in improving the living conditions.

g) Event Description: Under the action plan of SECL on the occasion of Amrut Mahotsav, the Sohagpur Area, SECL has done plantation work on 21.04.2023 at the OB dump of Dhanpuri OC Mine. A total of 3000 plant saplings were

planted on the site. The plant saplings were chosen from the local species with a mix of fruit bearing trees, flower plants, medicinal plants and timber plants. The motive of the plantation was to grow a natural forest landscape to develop a natural flora fauna.

During the plantation, executives of the Dhanpuri OC Mine and Area HQ of Sohagpur Area were present. The plantation will be taken care of by MP Rajya Van Vikas Nigam Limited for the next 5 years until it grows to sustain naturally.
