63rd Week programme of Azadit Ka Amrut Mahotsav was scheduled as " Anti Terrorism Day(21st May) organizing rallies to create awareness on anti terrorism" and organized in all Areas of SCCL.

Each year on May 21, Anti-Terrorism Day is observed on the death anniversary of former Prime Minister Sri Rajiv Gandhi. In 1991, he was assassinated in a suicide bombing by a woman belonging to the LTTE terrorist troop while campaigning at Sriperumbudur in Tamil Nadu.

The Chief of STPP Sri Sanjay Kumar Noor has inaugurated the peace rally at STPP (1200 MW power Station) Jaipur in which all employees, officers and contract employees have participated with displaying anti terrorism play cards and giving piece slogans in the residential colonies of STPP.
