The 75th week of "Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav" scheduled as "75 years Independence day Celebrations - Closing Ceremony of Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav" was organized in all the areas of SCCL.

As per instructions of Ministry of Coal a special programme "Har Ghar Tiranga" campaign was organized to encourage the employees to hoist the National Flag of India at their homes.
