

"Distribution of jute bags to employees" was organized during 80th Week of Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav instead of scheduled programme i.e. Corporate Social Responsibility: Distribution of Masks and Sanitizers in nearby Tribal Villages.

The above programme was organized from 13.09.2022 to 19.09.2022 in SCCL to create awareness among all employees at Mines and Departments about the Global pollution caused by excess usage of plastic and replacing plastic bags by jute bags.

Sri. Devendar, General Manager (Bellampalli area) has inaugurated the programme and addressed that it is an effort to increase awareness of the grave and vital problem of plastic pollution in the environment. It is very significant since plastic poses a huge threat to the ecosystem, notably to land and marine life, endangering the coming generations.

He told that due to excess usage of plastic, pollution was increased all over the world, it is all of our responsibility to keep a check on it and try to reduce the pollution level. This can be made possible by using jute bags instead of plastic bags. Jute is a completely biodegradable product. It can be recycled easily.

Further, he said that Jute bags can be used as many times as we want. Besides plastic bags, jute/paper bags seem to be the best alternative.
