Cancer is the leading cause of death globally, Prevention and Early detection is the only way to save the precious life. A team of experts from RST Cancer Hospital, examined the beneficiaries . The specific focus was on sensitizing and screening for oral, breast and cervical cancer. The following tests were conducted after registration during the camp - complete oral examination for oral cancer, comprehensive gynecological examination along with pap smear by gynecologist for women. Total 124 people availed the free cancer diagnostic services at the camp.

- g) Event Description: under the aegis of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, WCL Umrer Area has organized Free Eye Checkup Camp with help of SMM Eye Welfare Charitable Trust at SamudayakBhavan, Umrer Area HQ on 15th October, 2022. The outreach Camp organized under CSR has provided correct diagnosis and treatment/ postoperative follow-up from level the qualified ophthalmologist and to provide an effective way of reaching sections of the population who currently do not have Adequate eye care. Such camps can attend to refractive error correction, supply of spectacles and identification of conditions such as Cataract, Glaucoma, Diabetic Retinopathy and Corneal Opacities, etc. A total of 104 beneficiaries have visited the Outreach camp out of which 58 beneficiaries have been diagnosed with cataract. All advised cataract cases will be referred to Mahatme Eye Bank Eye Hospital for cataract surgery free of cost.

Shri. Pramod Agrawal, Chairman, CIL virtually inaugurated a 'Workshop on MDO Contract 2022', organised by Central Coalfields Ltd. at Darbhanga House, Ranchi.Dr. B. Veera Reddy, DT, CIL also addressed the workshop virtually. Shri. P.M.Prasad, CMD, CCL, Shri. Manoj Kumar CMD, CMPDI also spoke on the occasion. Over 100 participants from CIL and its companies are attending the two day workshop.

Mine Developer and Operator (MDO) is a model of operation of mines adopted in India. The MDO model was adopted in India because of limited resources which impacted production levels and also because subcontracting mining operations to private players was a more capital efficient way forward to improve production. It is imperative to note that the law does not define what an MDO is, and the MDO model is not a creature of a statute. Still, it is being increasingly adopted as the preferred model of coal mining operations in India due to the balance of autonomy it provides between private players and the PSUs. It is perceived as a more economically feasible mode of operation for both players. In this note, the authors have covered the working model of an MDO and the important legislations on coal mining in India.
