g) Event Description: Under the aegis of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, WCL Chandrapur Area has organised Free Cancer Screening & Detection Camp in Collaboration with RashtraSantTukdoji Regional Cancer Hospital & Research Centre(RSTRCH), Nagpur. On 21st October, 2022 a Free Cancer Screening & Detection Camp was held at Tirwanja(Mokasa) in Chandrapur District. A team of experts from RST Cancer Hospital examined the people and conducted various Diagnostic tests for screening of oral cancer, Breast, and Cervical Cancer. The team of doctors also sensitised people regarding Various types of Cancer and for screening of Oral, Breast and Cervical Cancer. A total of 104 people availed of the free cancer diagnostic services at the camp. A Mobile cancer detection bus consisting of an inbuilt pathology laboratory with auto-analyser and equipment for microbiological examination was used for this camp. The van also has a cabin for colonoscopy and breast scanning and a third cabin for diagnosis of oral cancer.

Under AKAM NCL has resolved that they would help in reducing the inequalities faced by the divyangjans by providing them artificial limbs and appliances. Prosthetic legs, or prostheses, can help people with leg amputations get around more easily. They mimic the function and, sometimes, even the appearance of a real leg. Some people still need a cane, walker or crutches to walk with a prosthetic leg, while others can walk freely. When an arm or other extremity is amputated or lost, a prosthetic device, or prosthesis, can play an important role in rehabilitation. For many people, an artificial limb can improve mobility and the ability to manage daily activities, as well as provide the means to stay independent. NCL in the context has signed MoU providing artificial limbs & appliances to Divyangs of Singrauli and Sonebhadra District for an amount of Rs. 2.83 Cr DDRC for Adoption of DDRC for providing artificial limbs & appliances.
