g) Event Description: Jute is the second most important vegetable fiber after cotton due to its versatility. Jute is used chiefly to make cloth for wrapping bales of raw cotton, and to make sacks and coarse cloth. The fibers are also woven into curtains, chair coverings, carpets, area rugs, hessian cloth, and backing for linoleum. Jute bags are cost effective and cheaper than plastic and paper bags. Strong and can carry more weight as compared to promotional carry bags. Durable and long lasting, not easy to tear like Plastic and Paper bags do. Jute has good insulating and antistatic properties, low thermal conductivity and a moderate moisture regain. As per directives received from the Ministry of Coal, GOI and MCL, HQ for Celebration of 2nd year of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM), the emphasis on high Jan Bhagidari & Public participation, MCL Basundhara Area has distributed 55 no. of reusable Jute bag to stop the use of single use plastic in Kuisira and Barpali village.

g) Event Description: Cataracts are the clouding of the lens of your eye, which is normally clear. Most cataracts develop slowly over time, causing symptoms such as blurry vision. Cataracts can be surgically removed through an outpatient procedure that restores vision in nearly everyone. When impaired vision from cataracts affects our ability to carry out daily activities -- for instance, driving or reading the newspaper -- the best option is cataract surgery to remove the cataract and replace it with an intraocular lens to permanently correct one's vision. Under AKAM, CIL organized 2nd special camp wherein elderly from Taki District of West Bengal was treated with Cataract removing operations free of cost. Untreated cataracts will eventually block light from entering the eye and result in a loss of vision. Worldwide, they are the leading cause of blindness. 100 operations were conducted on that day. HOD(CSR) along with representative from NGO were present at the venue along with needy patients.
