Monthly Summary for the Cabinet for the month of April, 2023 in respect of Ministry of Coal**Principal Activities**

The core objectives of the Ministry of Coal are to augment coal production by adopting state-of-the-art clean-coal technologies; enhancing exploration efforts with thrust on increasing proven coal resources and developing necessary infrastructure for prompt evacuation of coal for securing its availability to meet the demand of different sectors of the economy in an eco-friendly and sustainable manner.

Important achievements**A. Steps taken for sustained production of coal:**

- (a) Interactive session was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Coal) on 12.04.2023 with the all the coal block allottees.
- (b) Pre bid meeting was held under Chairmanship of Additional Secretary & Nominated Authority on 12.04.2023 with all the prospective bidders along with CMPDIL representatives.
- (c) 19th Scrutiny Committee meeting was held on 19.04.2023 and 20.04.2023 in which the show causes related to mines were deliberated.
- (d) Production in the month of April, 2023 from mines allocated under CM (SP) Act, 2015 is 9.37 Million Tonne.
- (e) Revenue in the month of April, 2023 from mines allocated under the CM (SP) Act, 2015 is Rs. 490.39 Crores.
- (f) The Coal Controller Organization has reported that the total production of coal from the allocated captive coal blocks for the month of April, 2023 is 9.488 Million Tonnes (Provisional), out of which, aggregate coal production of those coal blocks which have not been cancelled by the Hon'ble Supreme Court viz. Pakri Barwadiah (1.326 MT), Tasra (0.040 MT) and Moher & Moher Amlori Extn. (1.218 MT) is 2.584 Million Tonnes (Provisional).
- (g) On boarding of Coal Mines Pension Scheme-1998(CMPS-98) on DBT platform, by notifying CMPS-1998 under Section 7 of Aadhaar Act vide Gazette Notification No. SO.1728 (E) dated 13.04.2023.

B. Report on Progress: Details of progress in coal production, dispatch, e-auction of Coal viz-a viz target for the month of April, 2023 is given below-

- (a) Overall domestic coal production in the month of April, 2023 was 73.144 MT as against 67.202 MT in the month of April, 2022, registering a growth of about 8.84%. It includes coal production of 57.57 MT by Coal India Limited (CIL), 5.57 by Singareni Collieries Company Limited (SCCL) and 10.0 MT by Captive / Other mines.
- (b) Overall domestic coal dispatch in the month of April, 2023 was 80.306 MT as against 72.103 MT in the month of April, 2022, registering a growth of about 11.38%. It includes dispatch of 62.31 MT by CIL, 6.028 MT by SCCL and 11.968 MT by Captive / other mines.
- (c) Overall domestic coal supply to Power Sector in the month of April, 2023 by CIL and SCCL was 55.70 MT as against 54.02 MT in April, 2022.

E. Promotional Drilling: The programme for Promotional (Regional) drilling of 2.00 lakh meters (coal – 1.95 lakh metres and lignite – 0.05 lakh metres) has been drawn up in Annual Plan 2023-24 of CMPDI. The programme is under execution by MECL, DGMs of Nagaland & Assam and CMPDI. As against this, the achievement of drilling during the month of April 2023 is 0.059 lakh metre, against the target of 0.137 lakh metre, which is 44% of the target.

F. Overall Progress of Detailed Drilling in 2023-24: For 2023-24, annual plan target of 7.50 lakh metre of drilling (Departmental: 3.80 lakh metre, Outsourcing: 3.70 lakh metre) was fixed. As against this, 0.603 lakh metre of drilling has been carried out during the month of April 2023 against the target of 0.535 lakh metre, which is 113% of the target.
