## **ACHIEVEMENTS AT A GLANCE**

- Achieving record coal production and thereby ensuring adequate coal supply to thermal power plants and other sectors across the country, bringing about innovative policy reforms to give further fillip to India's energy security were some of the remarkable achievements of our Coal Sector during the year 2023.
- The all-India coal production for the calendar year 2023 is 968.61 Million Tonne (MT) (provisional) as compared to 864.26 MT coal during the same period of last year with a growth of about 12.07%.
- The all-India coal dispatch for the calendar year 2023 is 950.13 Million Tonne (MT) (provisional) as compared to 860.19 MT coal during the same period of last year with a growth of about 10.46%.
- Successful allocation of **157 coal mines** since 2015 under transparent commercial coal mine auction, holding Investors' Conclave in different parts of the country, signing of crucial MoUs for Coal Gasification projects with premiere organizations like BHEL, IOCL, GAIL (India) are some of the major highlights of Coal Ministry's achievements during the year.
- The total revenue generated till December 2023 from the Coal blocks allocated by Nominated authority is Rs.18154.79 crore (excluding Royalty, taxes, cess etc.).
- As of now total 91 coal mines have successfully been auctioned under commercial mining having Peak Rated Capacity (PRC) of ~222 MTPA. Once fully operational, these mines will generate an

- annual revenue of ~Rs. 33,086 crores calculated on the basis of the PRC and provide employment to 3,00,137 persons.
- Total Capex of CIL, SCCL and NLCIL during CY 2023 was 26780.88 Cr.
- ↑ The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi have approved proposal for equity investment in two PIT-Head Thermal Power Projects (i) 1×660 MW Supercritical Coal-Based Thermal Power Plant (TPP) at Amarkantak Thermal Power Station, Anuppur District, Madhya Pradesh (ii) 2×800 MW Supercritical Thermal Power Plant, in Sundergarh District, Odisha.
- Moving ahead towards Smarter & Greener Infrastructure, **31 First Mile Connectivity (FMC) projects with 291 MTPA capacity** and 3 railway projects were commissioned out of 15 railway projects taken up for coal evacuation.
- During January 2023 to November, 2023, 2,513 LKL volume of treated mine water has been supplied for community purposes of which 1,193 LKL has been supplied for drinking purpose and 2,320 LKL has been supplied for irrigation purposes.
- During January 2023 to November, 2023, Coal/ Lignite PSUs planted 53.48 lakh saplings on 2,711 Ha.
- During January 2023 to November, 2023, Coal / Lignite PSUs developed 4 Eco-park/Mine Tourism sites.
