*Dear Sir,*

With regard to significant activities of Ministry of Coal during September 2025, information in respect of point no. (i) to (iii) specified in your DO letter No. 1/50/3/2024-Cab. dated 24.10.2024 is NIL and details on Departmental Indicators as per the format circulated vide your DO letter of even number dated 03.12.2024 is annexed.

2. With respect to point no. (iv) *ibid.*, regarding significant developments, I would like to inform that the overall coal production in September, 2025 is 67.40 MT as compared to 68.90 MT during the same period last year. The coal stock at the Domestic Coal Based Thermal Power Plants end as on 30.09.2025 is 42.80 MT as compared to 33.22 MT of the same period last year with a growth of 28.83%. At the level of actual consumption, this coal stock is sufficient for 18 days (approx. @2.30 MT/day of consumption).

3. Further, I would like to highlight the following major developments during the month of September, 2025:


- i. Subsequent to the necessary amendment in the MMDR Act for setting up of "Mineral Exchange", the Draft Coal Exchange Rules, 2025 have been published on the website of Ministry of Coal for public consultation on 16.09.2025.
- ii. Under the Coal Gasification Scheme, Request for Proposals (RFPs) for the second round of the Financial Incentive Scheme, aimed at utilizing the balance fund of ₹2,366.94 crores out of the sanctioned outlay of ₹8,500 crores was published on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025.
- iii. As part of the progress of defined activities in implementation of the Jharia Master Plan, rooftop solar installation in 100 blocks has been completed. Further, work has commenced for 40 LED street lighting and 26 shops have provisionally been allotted.

- iv. Imparting a further impetus to the diversification agenda of the Coal PSUs, the Hon'ble Prime Minister laid the foundation stone for NLCIL's 600 MW and CIL's 300 MW solar projects at Khavda and 50 MW wind project at Dayapar in Kutch, both in Gujarat, on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2025.
- v. Further, NLCIL has successfully commissioned 8.8 MW out of the planned 50 MW solar power project in a mined-out area.
- vi. On 8<sup>th</sup> September 2025, NIRL (NLC India Renewables Limited), a wholly owned subsidiary of NLCIL, signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with PTC India Limited for development of renewable energy projects including solar, wind, hybrid, pumped storage, battery storage, green hydrogen, green ammonia, solar parks, and other clean energy initiatives.


