NOTIFICATION

No.MII-159(18)/54-A. - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 (67 of 1957), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules to amend the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Mineral Concession (Third Amendment) Rules, 1961.

2. In the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960, after rule 59, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:-

- "70. Sand not be treated as minor mineral when used for certain purposes. Sand shall not be treated as a minor mineral when used for any of the following purposes, namely:-
- (i) purposes of refractory and manufacture of ceramic.
  - (ii) metallurgical purposes.
  - (iii) optical purposes.
  - (iv) purposes of stowing in coal mines."
