MII-169(44)/61.- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules to amend the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 1961.
2. In the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960 -
 - (i) in sub-rule (3) of rule 11 after the words 'for reasons to be recorded in writing' the words "and communicated to be the applicant" shall be inserted;
 - (ii) after clause (m) of sub-rule (1) of rule 27, the following clause shall be inserted, namely:-

"(n) in the absence of ready market for low grade ores, the lessee/lessees who is/are operating or has/have undertaken to set up beneficiation plants, should properly store such low grade ore for future beneficiation;"
 - (iii) in sub-rule (5) of rule 28, after the words 'for reasons to be recorded in writing', the words "and communicated to the applicant" shall be inserted;
 - (iv) in rule 33, after the words 'shall be made', the words "by the State Government" shall be inserted;
 - (v) in schedule I -
 - (a) in Form J after sub-item (c) of item (xi) of para 2, the following shall be inserted namely:-

"(d) particulars of existing or created dumps of ore, if any".
 - (b) in Form K, in part VII relating to the covenants of the lessee/lessees, in covenants 7, after the words 'inspecting, examining, surveying', the word "prospecting" shall be inserted.

No. MII-164(12)/61, - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 (67 of 1957), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Mineral Concession (Second Amendment) Rules, 1961.
2. In the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960, rule 58 shall be re-numbered as sub-rule (1) thereof and after sub-rule (1) as so re-numbered, the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:-
"(2) The Central Government may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax the provisions of sub-rule (1) in any special case."
