NOTIFICATION

GSR 369

1(26)/66-MII - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 (67 of 1957), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960, namely:-

1. (i) These rules may be called the Mineral Concession (First Amendment) Rules, 1967.
- (ii) These rules come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960 -
 - (i) for the words "Director, Geological Survey of India" wherever they occur, the words "Director-General, Geological Survey of India" should be substituted;
 - (ii) in rule 66, in sub-rule (1), -
 - (a) in clause (a), after the word "Calcutta", the words "and to the Director of Geology and Mining of the State in which the prospecting or mining operations are carried on" shall be inserted;
 - (b) in clause (b), after the words "Secretary, Department of Atomic Energy, New Delhi", the words "and to the Director of Geology and Mining of the State in which the prospecting or mining operations are carried on" shall be inserted;

- (iii) in rule 66A, in clause (i) of sub-rule(1), for the words "he shall report the fact to the Director, Atomic Minerals Division, New Delhi within 60 days from the date of discovery of such mines", the words "he shall within 60 days from the date of discovery of such mines, report the fact of such discovery to the Director, Atomic Minerals Division, New Delhi and the Director of Geology and Mining of the State in which the prospecting or mining operations are carried on" shall be inserted.
