NOTIFICATION

No.1(52)/63-MII - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 (67 of 1957), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960, namely:-

- (1) These rules may be called the Mineral Concession (First Amendment) Rules, 1965.
- (2) In the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960, in Schedule I, in Form F, in clause (4) of Part IV, for the words "until the mining lease is granted", the words "until his application for mining lease is disposed of or deemed to have been refused under sub-rule (1) or sub-rule (3), as the case may be, of rule 24 of the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960, or any other law in force" shall be substituted.

New Delhi, the 12th January, 1965.

No. 11(18)/63-MII. - In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (2) and (4) of section 17 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 (67 of 1957), the Central Government, after consultation with the Government of the State of Orissa, hereby -

- (i) declares that the Central Government proposes to undertake prospecting and mining operations in respect of iron ore in the State of Orissa in the area specified in the Schedule hereto annexed; and
- (ii) declares that no prospecting licence or mining lease shall be granted in respect of any land specified in the said Schedule.


