NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation & Development) Act, 1957 (67 of 1957), The Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960, namely :-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Mineral Concession (Fourth Amendment) Rules, 1971.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official gazette.
2. In the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960,-
 - (1) In rule 13, after sub-rule (3), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely :-
"(4) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1), where an application for grant or renewal of a Prospecting licence is refused on account of any lapse on the part of the applicant, the fees paid by the applicant shall be forfeited to the State Government.";

(ii) in rule 25, after sub-rule (2), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:-

"(3) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1), where an application for grant or renewal of a mining lease is refused on account of any lapse on the part of the applicant the fees paid by the applicant shall be forfeited to the State Government."
